



Teodoro tiene un dálmata llamado Daltón.


# ¡Muy lindo, entretenido y tan tontito! Daltón toma el dado y tira el dardo.






No le tiene miedo a nada; Ni a una tormenta ni a una rata... ¡Mentirita!

Diariamente entran un animalito, otro animalito, y otro animalito a que le atiendan.








La tienda de Teodoro tiene de todo: De diente de león a nidito de ratón, de un duende a un enanito y de un tetero a un dardito.





# Teodoro y Daltón tienen un lorito doradito y redondito llamado Mateito. Mateito mantiene dormidito en el nidito.




## Daltón no lo deja dormir. Mateito le dijo a Daltón:






Tan dañino Daltón, toma la tuna y la daña de una.


Él toma el tamarindo y lo daña a mordedura.





Daltón daña lo que tiene alrededor, y muerde con un diente al león.

La arañita le tiene miedo, el león le tiene miedo. ¡Qué malito el dalmita!


Mateito, el lorito doradito y redondito de Teodoro, mantenía muy enojado. Un día dijo:



# Mateito dejó una notita: "¡Me iré donde me dejen dormir!"



Al otro día, Teodoro y Daltón dejaron la tienda ¡Tomaron el timón y manejaron intentando hallar al adorado lorito Mateito!




## Durante un día y medio, Teodoro y el Dálmata dormían en un matorral.







Daltón lo tomó en la mano y con un dedito lo mimó.




# El Dálmata le dijo a Mateito:
