

Start a Smile Train Club At Your School!

Thanks for wanting to help Smile Train! With Students for Smile Train, you and your school can make a real difference for kids in need around the world.

Starting a Smile Train club is fun and easy — and we're here to help!

Here are some ways to get your club started on the right foot.



Define the Purpose of Your Club: Write down your club's mission, goals, and what you want to achieve. This includes what your club is trying to accomplish and how you hope to impact students and the school.



Secure a Club Advisor: The first step in starting a club at your school is to secure a teacher or administrator as an advisor.



Schedule a Meeting: Decide when and where to have your first meeting and how you would like to advertise it. What is the best way to tell your fellow students about the club?



Meeting Brainstorm: At your first meeting, share a <u>presentation and video about Smile Train</u> and prepare talking points for a discussion with your meeting attendees. Some question ideas are below.

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- How would you like to structure the club? Will you have set titles (President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, etc.), or will responsibilities be assigned on an ad hoc basis?
- How often would you like to meet? What would you like to cover at these meetings? Smile Train will provide you with different resources and videos for each meeting.
- What are your fundraising goals? All funds donated to Smile Train help support safe and quality cleft care for children globally. How are you going to collect funds? Setting up an <u>online fundraising</u> <u>page</u> with a personalized URL is a great way to keep track of all funds raised.
- How are you going to hit your fundraising goals? Events are a great way to raise awareness of clefts AND funds in support of Smile's Train's programs. Check out some Smile Train fundraising ideas in this guide and read stories of past fundraisers here.

- Consider setting up a social media account for your club (e.g., Instagram, Facebook, or Twitter).
